Your TIRRA membership fee covers expenses incurred for trail maintenance, insurance, welcome packages, eSPOKES, and advocating for transportation issues with highways and ferries.

Thetis Island Community Association:

TICA, which has CRA charitable status, receives no funding through taxation but is supported solely through annual membership fees, fundraising, donations, and grants. TICA owns the Forbes Hall Community Centre and its surrounding grounds, sports court, and outdoor pavilion. It maintains these facilities for the enjoyment and use of all islanders. TICA also facilitates public WIFI access on the premises and provides the *Quarterly* magazine to all TICA members.

Even if you do not use the services provided, their availability makes Thetis Island a better place to live or visit.

The newly re-opened Forbes Hall Community Centre includes a large flexible space for many activities, including the library, food services, a meeting room, and two large rooms for community gatherings, exercise, education, arts, culture, worship services, and more. It is also the Thetis Island Emergency Social Services site in case of disaster.

Please note that at the virtual AGM held April 2021, the Membership approved an increase to the annual membership fees effective 2022, the last raise was in 2011. TICA gratefully accepts donations and issues tax receipts for all donations over \$25.
