

TIRRA Trail Report - October 20, 2019

TIRRA trail stewards participated in a joint trail workshop in partnership with ThINC on October 19th. There were 30 participants with facilitator Riley MacIntosh of the Cowichan Valley. TIRRA contributed 50% of the cost of this workshop.

Chris Call volunteered his time and expertise to clear fallen trees on the Lawrence Valley Loop trail.

Elisabeth Bond has secured grant funds to proceed with a pollinator demonstration garden that will be located at the head of the Dingly Dell Trail. Construction of the garden and information kiosk will begin in the near future.

The trail committee requested TIRRA to notify two web trail sites, advising them to remove postings identifying Thetis trails that hold licences on private property. Should property owners wish to have their trails posted on a public site, they can give permission to these sites.
